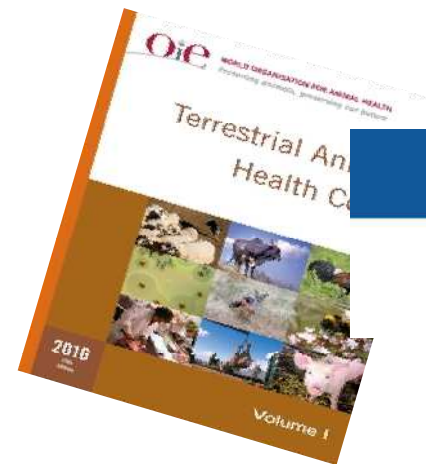

Animal health law

Prevention is better than cure

Directive 92/65



- Council Directive 92/65/EEC of 13. July 1992 laying down animal health requirements governing trade in and imports into the Community of animals, semen, ova and embryos.

National Legislation



- Any national legislation has to follow the AHL and Council Directive 92/65
- Collection centres of germinal products have to fulfill the obligations of 92/65
- Material of elder Collections cannot fulfill this requirements.
